



Fastening Recommendations

- Align the panels with as many studs as possible. Ideally, fasten the slatwall in all studs 16" on center across the width of the panel, and vertically about 12" apart.
- Fasten panels directly to studs with 1-1/2" screws, or 2" screws if going through drywall.
- If either end of the panel does not fall on a stud, use an appropriate drywall anchors to secure the ends.
- Pre-drill metal inserts and screw through the back of the insert to anchor it to the stud.
- It is recommended to use furring strips when attaching to concrete or masonry.

Storage and Handling

TRUPAN MDF products should never be stored or used outdoors. The indoor storage area should be clean, dry, well ventilated, and free of dust, dirt or particles that could contaminate the MDF. Store flat on stickers on a level, hard, dry surface. Constant relative humidity and temperature should be maintained. Before use, acclimatize for 48 - 72 hours to the same conditions as are expected after the panel is installed. For more information, see Composite Panels
